Soli Deo Gloria: A Celebration of Handel's Messiah

Since its modest debut in Dublin, George Frideric Handel's Messiah has gained immense popularity and is now the most performed choral work in Western music. The oratorio was originally written for Easter, but



now has become a fixture of the Advent and Christmas seasons. In conjunction with the community choir presentation of Messiah on December 11, our Advent worship will feature various pieces from **Messiah.** We will use these pieces as an avenue into the Scriptures on which the oratorio is based, as well as deepen our knowledge and appreciation of Handel's masterwork. The title for this series, Soli Deo Gloria, means "to God alone the glory." Handel closed his manuscript with this phrase by using the letters "SDG." Our celebration of Advent and Christmas should absolutely bring glory to God alone.

Winter Worship Series: January 8 - February 19 **New Year. Same Promises**

"New year, new you!" is the message we get every January 1st from culture, year after year. We vow to make make changes to our diet, exercise habits, or lifestyle, but, in spite of those resolutions, most things

stay the same. This may be cause for disappointment, but there is some consistency we can celebrate. God's promises to us do not change with the calendar or the latest fitness trend. Rather than focusing our energy on making (and in all likelihood breaking) promises to ourselves, let's spend the first part of the new year appreciating God's unbreakable promises.

> **Lenten Worship Series**: February 22 - April 7 Selah: Stop. Pause. Listen.

The Hebrew term "selah" appears over seventy times in the Psalms. While the definition is obscure, most scholars interpret it to mean a pause, break, or interruption; suggesting a rest from routine activities. This describes how we should understand our posture throughout the forty days of Lent. It is time to rest from our normal routines and make more room for Christ. Thus, the trajectory for this Lenten season is a renewed spirit. The Psalms provide a myriad of examples on how to make this renewal a reality. We will explore some of these Psalms during this Lent.
