#### Lenten Worship Series: Beginning February 22 Selah: Stop. Pause. Listen.

The Hebrew term "selah" appears over seventy times in the Psalms. While the definition is obscure, most scholars interpret it to mean a pause, break, or interruption; suggesting a rest from routine activities. This describes how we should understand our posture throughout the forty days of Lent. It is time to rest from our normal routines and make more room for Christ. Thus, the trajectory for this Lenten season is a renewed spirit. The Psalms provide a myriad of examples on how to make this renewal a reality. We will explore some of these Psalms during this Lent.
